## How do we help Youth connect?

This service is set up to assist young people, primarily between the ages of 15 – 17 years to transition from school to further training or employment.

Young people register with the service and receive help to transition into either training or employment after they have left or are thinking of leaving school. We can help a young person to get their birth certificate, curriculum vitae, career plan and much more!

YTS works closely with Rina Hudson & Associates and Careers NZ to ensure our young people receive specialist career guidance and an action plan. It is important that we connect young people with opportunities that will assist them in engaging in future learning so that they can pursue employment and career opportunities – now and in the future. **Check out Daniel's story!**
